



## Encana Canadian Division - ISNetwork Subscription and Exemption Criteria

Category	Required to subscribe	NOT required to subscribe*	Exemption Basis
<b>Contractors</b>	On-site contractors. (Sites include seismic, drilling, construction, mod yards, operating sites, etc.)	Off-site contractors (e.g. fab shops, trailer manufacturing, electrical house supply).	No work on Encana sites.
		Single person contract supervisors/operators working directly for Encana as "staff contractors".	Encana safety systems apply.
<b>Service Providers</b>	On-site service providers (e.g. vacuum truck, cranes, and medical services).	Off-site service providers (e.g. deliveries to town office, automobile contractors, rental companies, janitorial for town offices).	No work on Encana site; only limited "visits" to Encana sites.
	Engineering and other consulting companies (e.g. environmental, monitoring, etc.) that work on Encana's sites.	"Office only" engineering and consulting (e.g. project scoping, economic analysis, legal services, accounting, and "staff contractors").	No work on Encana site; only limited "visits" to Encana sites.
	Air charter carriers performing <i>other</i> field-based services that require ISN safety prequalification (e.g. ground medic services)	Air charter carriers on Encana's approved air carrier list providing air/helicopter services only.	Prequalified by corporate travel.
<b>Equipment Contractors</b>	Tagged equipment contractors / installers (e.g. pumps, compressors, vessels).	Tagged equipment vendors (e.g. pumps, compressors, vessels).	No work on Encana site – do not install equipment. Only limited "visits" to Encana sites for warranty reviews if necessary.
	Bulk materials contractors / installers (e.g. pipe supply and install, concrete supply and placement).	Bulk materials vendors (e.g. pipe mills and distributors, cement plant).	
	Fabrication contractors working at the Encana Nisku mod yard.	Fabrication contractors working at their own mod yards and shipping product to Encana sites.	
<b>Landowners/ Rural Residents</b>		Landowners performing work on their own lands (owned/leased/rented).	No work on Encana sites.
		Rural residents performing minor maintenance and support services such as snow clearing, snow removal, providing access to a wellhead etc., are exempt provided: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. they operate under an executed and written agreement with Encana;</li> <li>2. the work does not provide the primary income for the rural resident;</li> <li>3. they operate as a single person entity; and,</li> <li>4. the rural resident has taken out the appropriate wellhead insurance (if relevant)</li> </ol> <p>The rural resident exemption does not apply to activities involving ground disturbance, chemicals, herbicides, pesticides and electrical work.</p>	Limited "visits" to Encana sites. Low volume, low hazard work. Other mitigative controls in place.

\* Project managers or operations superintendents may increase requirements at their discretion and require pre-qualification of these categories based upon business need (e.g. Asset Risk may require pre-qualification even if People Risk is not in Encana's control)
